

## English Task

Hi Year 4,

We have 3 tasks for you to complete during your stay at home. You don't need to complete the tasks all at once; you may spread them out across the week.

Please ensure that the tasks are completed as neatly as possible in your homework book.

### Task 1 - To write a narrative

Your narrative must be a story set in a magical forest. Let your imagination flow and try to write as creatively and descriptively as you can.

Remember – Your story must include an opening, a build-up, a dilemma and an ending. Write using paragraphs. Once you have completed your story, you may illustrate your favourite part.

### Task 2 – To write a diary entry

Write a diary entry of your 'perfect day'. Recall the example that was read in the class and make your diary entry as interesting as possible.

Remember to use the first person (I), the past tense (swam, ran, painted, ate) and a range of adverbials to move your writing on.

### Task 3 – To compose an acrostic poem and a Haiku

Your acrostic poem must be about the forest. Remember to lay out your poem correctly (see below)
